



TEAM BC MANAGER and CHAPERONE APPLICATION

- Canadian Championships (trampoline), July 20-24, 2022 - Calgary, BC

Eligibility:

Interested persons must be 19 years or older, preferably a coach, judge or parent with a related interest in the sport, have a valid class 5 British Columbia driver's license, and if selected, also provide a criminal record check (Gymnastics BC will provide code to use the online process for free).

Role and Responsibilities:

Successful applicants will work with the Provincial Team. Applicants will be expected to be available for the duration of the competition. Prior to the event, required tasks include but are not limited to assisting with arranging/obtaining uniforms for the athletes and coaches, maintaining a line of communication between Gymnastics BC, the manager, chaperones, clubs, coaches, athletes and parents. Expenses such as accommodation, meals and registration will be covered by GBC. A Team BC uniform will be available for loan or purchase by you.

During the event, the managers, chaperones and coaches must work together in a manner that supports the optimal performance of the athletes.

Manager and chaperones are expected to be available 24/7 as athletes can get sick in the middle of the night, etc. Applicants must be able to sustain a moderate level of physical activity as there is a lot of walking involved between the different venues. The applicants must also be aware that their first and foremost responsibility is to the athletes they are chaperoning, and there is a real possibility that they may not be able to watch their child compete in all events due to their staff duties. However, every effort will be made by the staffing team for you to be able to watch your child compete.
