Teams are not permitted to bring personal boards or Yurchenko mats to the event. Please note: The GymBC floor includes a Birch bottom and a Moscow top. Please email equipment@gymbc.org if you have any questions.
ACCREDITATION	 All athletes, coaches, and team delegation will be required to wear an accreditation tag, which will be handed out upon arrival. Chaperones, team managers, and heads of delegation must register (with no fee) so that accreditation may be made for them.
COMPLIANCE	 All coaches, judges, and team support staff assigned to Westerns must meet their own provincial/territorial association's requirement regarding SafeSport. This includes (but is not limited to): NCCP minimum certifications, Respect in Sport certification, Criminal Record Check, etc.
DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE AND MEDIA RELEASE	 In order to participate in this event, each participating PTSO must sign a Declaration of Compliance Form and submit it to GymBC with your registration fees. By signing this document, you are also ensuring that your organization has attained a media release form for all participating athletes, coaches, judges and team staff that may appear on camera during the competition, and giving GymBC and Langley Gymnastics Foundation permission to post media to social media channels and websites during and after the competition. If you need a media release form template, please contact safety@gymbc.org This form also ensures that you have conducted thorough and essential compliance checks on participating coaches, judges, and team staff including criminal record checks and any other necessary evaluations or verifications.
