| INVITED MEMBERS ELIGIBILITY | <p>All members who met the eligibility requirements according to the WCC protocol document.</p> <p><u>ATHLETES</u> Athletes who are in good standing with their Provincial/Territorial Federation/Association are eligible to register.</p> <p><u>COACHES</u> Coaches of Trampoline and Double Mini must be fully certified a Minimum of NCCP 2/TG Comp 1 Trampoline. Tumbling coaches may be fully certified NCCP Level 2/Comp 1 Artistic or Trampoline.</p> <p>Upon request, an exemption of 1 year will be granted by their PSO for coaches without proper certification, providing they have a mentor coach available to work with them at the event.</p> <p>All coaches must have completed Respect in Sport and have a valid Policy Record Check.</p> <p>All coaches must follow GymCan and Western Canada Cup policies/rules regarding coaching attire.</p> <p>Coaches wearing inappropriate or non-Provincial/Club Team attire will be asked by the Meet Director, Competition Head Judge, or their representative, to leave the competition floor.</p> | | |

EVENTS

Trampoline: L1 12U / L1 13+ / L2 12U / L2 13+ / L3 14U / L3 15+ / L4 14U / L4 15+ Double Mini: L1 12U / L1 13+ / L2 12U / L2 13+ / L3 14U / L3 15+ / L4 14U / L4 15+ Tumbling: L1 12U / L1 13+ / L2 12U / L2 13+ / L3 14U / L3 15+ / L4 14U / L4 15+ Synchro: L1 / L2 / L3 / L4

Following the registration deadline, all the categories will be reviewed to determine that the numbers in each age group is well suited for a good competitive experience. Some age groups may be re-aligned OR amalgamated in order to achieve this goal.

Groups in excess of **30** athletes will be split by Gymnastics Canada age splits. There will only be one split per level

COMPETITION FORMAT

All GymCan rules will apply for the competition, except that there will be no finals for synchronized trampoline. In case of a tie at any place after the preliminary round, the GymCan Tie Breaker rule shall apply.

MOBILITY FOR DMTL4 - "mobility finals" will be added for any L4 athletes who has met the mobility requirements in preliminaries but had not qualified for finals, 11th place and up. These athletes will not be eligible for awards.

One optional routine shall be completed for all levels of Synchronized Trampoline

MEDICAL

First Responders will provide medical services on-site during training and competition. Club managers and/or head coaches may be asked to produce digital or hard copy medical waivers to access medical care for minors on site.

MEDICAL WAIVER, PARENT CONSENT & PIPA

Each PSO or Club must submit their Statutory Declaration via [Activity Messenger](#) in advance of their arrival to the competition.

SCORING

The SportzSoft program will be used.

ATTIRE

All GymCan rules apply for proper attire for specific and general warm-up and competition. Athletes can wear either male or female TEAM uniform.

TEAM FINAL

The Provincial / Territorial Teams of each participating province/territory do not automatically participate in each Event Team Final. The Team Event is open to all clubs at the competition as long as they have at least three athletes in the event.

Teams wishing to be included in the Team Final must register and pay a \$25 registration fee

- The eight teams (four L3/4 and four L1/2, compete in each event (TRI, TUM and DMT) of the Event Team Final) will submit their four (4) athlete's names who will compete in the Event Team Final.
- Team can choose their four (4) representatives without hindrance, regardless of gender or level.
